

## Nanaimo Amateur Radio Association (NARA)

### Constitution

- 1) The name of the Society (herein “the Association”) be incorporated under the Society Act is “Nanaimo Amateur Radio Association (NARA)”.
- 2) The purposes of the Association are:
  - (a) To foster Amateur Radio Activity;
  - (b) To encourage community involvement;
  - (c) To encourage and foster the application of techniques through experimentation and construction of amateur radio equipment and antennas;
  - (d) To engage in and promote more effective Emergency Communications in concert with the local authorities.
- 3) The operation of the Association is to be chiefly carried on in and about the Regional District of Nanaimo. This provision is alterable.
- 4) The purpose of the Association shall be carried out without purpose of gain for its members and any profits or additions to the assets of the Society shall be used for promoting its services. This provision is unalterable.
- 5) In the event of winding-up or dissolution of the Association the funds and assets of the Association remaining after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities, shall not be given or transferred to any person or persons other than Canadian Amateur Radio Federation of its successor. This provision is unalterable.
